REGISTRATION

Interested participants may register at www.askfred.net. When signing up for seminar, please indicate the weapon(s) in which you wish to be tested. Sign up separately for each practical exam you will be taking.

PREPARATION

If you plan to take any written test, you must prepare by diving headfirst into the USFA Rulebook and the Official Study Guide. Links are available to each document at the registration site on AskFred.

The New Orleans Fencing Club and the Louisiana Division of the U.S.F.A. will host a two-day referee clinic at the Tennis and Health Club at the rear of the Hilton complex, 2 Poydress St., New Orleans, La. This official USFA Fencing Commission Referee's Seminar and practical examinations will be conducted by Justin Meehan. Meehan will conduct a seminar on Saturday, March 13, and practical exams on Sunday March 14. The Seminar will focus on:

- real life experiences and anecdotes
- common sense approaches to refereeing
- tactics and techniques needed to reach the next level
- making sense of the rules.

THE NEW REF'S OPEN

The Referees' clinic will be accompanied by a three-weapon open mixed tournament on Sunday, March 14th, 2010, at the Hilton fitness center. The tournament will be held in order to provide a venue for the practical examination of the referee clinic attendants.

All USFA Rules Apply. USFA membership is required. Fencers must be 13



and older in order to compete in the tournament.
